



Description of Services – More Details

- Consult with the student and his or her parent (s) to assess needs, and goals related to choosing a college or planning a gap year.
- Evaluation of the student's academic transcript, their extra-curricular activities, work experience, volunteer hours, and career objectives.
- Direction concerning the PSAT, SAT, ACT, AP Exams and SAT II
- Create a customized college list
- Provide full understanding and information with regards to early decision and early action options. Explore these options as they relate to the individual student.
- Guidance regarding college visits and tips as to how to evaluate and document school visits in a thoughtful, insightful and organized way.
- Use of self-assessment inventories to provide the insight necessary to generate colleges that are well matched to the student's emotional, social and intellectual preferences.
- Brainstorm topics and edit college application essays.
